_____ **Fundraising:** This committee will have several subcommittees which are listed below. **All committee volunteers** are encouraged to bring in a list of potential donor contacts. **This committee will also help with the upcoming Make a Miracle conference.** The whole committee should be prepared to brainstorm with other volunteers on setting up an annual sponsored Aniridia Foundation International fundraiser and creating/publishing suggested ideas for individual fundraising efforts.

_____ **Communications:** In addition to general communications tasks, this committee will also have **three subcommittees** who will work with the AFI office and other committees in communication tasks of events, exhibiting, news, marketing, graphics and social media, etc. In addition, those chosen for leadership positions will help to share the AFI approved timely information and get requested information from supporters.

- The **Social Media** subcommittee - Volunteers will be assigned a moderating task in the AFI private forum area based on their application and experience or other tasks. Additionally, these volunteers will assist a supervisor with Facebook and Twitter according to the Volunteer Handbook Social Media rules.
- The **Marketing and Graphic Design of Materials** subcommittee (**experience required**): Will help create awareness with campaign materials, conference materials, and other Aniridia Foundation International information.
- The **Eye on Aniridia (EOA) News Edition and Website**: Will take an active part in writing and gathering articles for the AFI news edition, *Eye on Aniridia* or help with the website. **Some writing and/or computer experience is required, however, assistance by our EOA staff.**

_____ **Education and Social Support:** Will help guide our supporters with education and social support issues. People with professional experience in teaching, VI, O&M, nurses, psychologists, etc would be of great interest. Also, peer support and knowledge of adaptive devices from visually impaired supporters who wish to be on this committee will be chosen based upon their application, experience, and one-page bio. Some volunteers will be asked to moderate a forum area specific to your area of expertise in our private forum area.

_____ **Research:** Committee members with research or medical knowledge will search for peer-reviewed published articles for the private forum area and help with various tasks related to the AFI research protocol, the vetting of Medical / Scientific advisory council members, previewing the research funding applications and various tasks related to the AFI Medical Registry program.
